Updates from USBE

Licensure Levels- Effective January 1, 2020

- Associate and Professional license levels
- ARL/APT will no longer be in place as of January 1, 2020
- Anyone seeking licensure (prepared through Higher Ed., School Districts, or Charter Schools) will be held to same standards and must demonstrate compliance through approved performance assessment that meet state requirements. The criteria will be set by USBE.
- No official documentation of the change has been posted to the USBE website.

R277-304 Teacher Preparation (see attached document)

• Official policy indicating specific criteria required for teacher preparation

Performance Assessments Effective January 1, 2020

- R277-304 includes specific information on performance assessment. Licensure groups will have freedom to choose a Performance Assessment tool to document the requirements Options:
 - o Institutionally created tool
 - Too time consuming to develop and validate.
 - State-generated tools
 - PACT California tool
 - o edTPA (Pearson)
 - UVU currently uses this tool
 - PPAT (ETS)

Tool we will likely adopt

• Regardless of the tool, faculty training will be required.

PPAT (see attached document)

- ETS Training Scheduled for September 6, 2019- Details TBD
- U moving forward with PPAT
- New performance assessment tool will be implanted into students' program for those admitted by January 2020 or later. We will begin implementing the tool into 20-21 or 21-22 cohorts.
- PLT Praxis test will be replaced

High Leverage Practices- Teaching Works – University of Michigan

- Standard Expectations that need to be demonstrated-These were shared at the fall meeting
- We have a committee who will identify how our program meets these expectations.

Advising

- Updates on Enrollments
 - Elementary numbers up about 24%
 - The number of students pursuing degrees in the Humanities is down locally and nationally.
 - Perhaps there are opportunities such as Digital Literacies within Humanities
- Student Ambassadors
 - Hiring undergrads to help with recruiting. Summer 19 will include 2 Fine Arts teaching majors

Content Area Supervision and Methods Courses

- During the past 2 years we have implemented content area experts (Math, Science, Art) to supervise and provide support for Secondary Interns/student teachers.
 - We plan to expand to other content areas. We understand the value of that content support.
- Methods Courses, Lesson Planning, Evaluation Standards, Field work
 - UITE created unified lesson plan rubric- Common Language/goals across content methods.
- Field Practica Mentoring Site

Interns and Granit School District

- During the 19-20 year we will have 16 elementary interns
